

He completed his Ph.D. in Dentistry at Fluminense Federal University (UFF) in 2017, focusing on clinical trials. Dr. Mourão further pursued postdoctoral research in Biotechnology at UFF from 2017 to 2022 and in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at UFF from 2018 to 2020. Dr. Mourão has published more than 160 indexed peerreviewed articles.


