

Key topics include patient assessment, imaging interpretation, complication management, and postoperative care. Attendees will gain real-world experience by performing extractions on live patients under expert supervision.

Upon completion, participants will confidently manage simple and complex cases, earning a certificate recognizing their advanced clinical training.

- Assess patients for third molar extractions using diagnostic imaging.
- Perform surgical techniques such as flap design and bone removal.
- Manage complications like dry socket and infections.
- Practice suturing techniques for optimal wound closure.
- Build confidence through supervised hands-on training.

In 2012, he earned a Master's degree in Surgical Sciences from the School of Medicine at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ), gaining extensive experience in experimental research. He completed his Ph.D. in Dentistry at Fluminense Federal University (UFF) in 2017, focusing on clinical trials. Dr. Mourão further pursued post-doctoral research in Biotechnology at UFF from 2017 to 2022 and in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at UFF from 2018 to 2020. Dr. Mourão has published more than 170 indexed peer-reviewed articles.
