# COURSE CONTENT

## A 4-day course of hands-on with real patients

Refine your surgical skills in implant dentistry with our intensive course for practicing dentists. The program includes hands-on training on real patients to enhance dental implant techniques, guaranteeing a **minimum of 15 implants per doctor**. Participants will learn to evaluate radiography (X-rays and Cone Beam Computed Tomography), perform single and multiple implant placements, apply immediate post-extraction implant methods, and practice guided bone regeneration (GBR), including the management of platelet-rich fibrin (PRF). The course also covers hands-free and guided implant placement tools and techniques, as well as the management of complications in dental implant surgeries. After completing the program, participants will be able to return to their practice and provide predictable implant therapy with confidence and expertise.

## LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Evaluate radiographic information for implant procedures.
- Demonstrate and operate single implant placement.
- Practice techniques for multiple implant placements.
- Apply immediate post-extraction implant placement methods.
- Practice guided bone regeneration (GBR) on dental implant placement, including the management of platelet-rich fibrin (PRF).
- Operate guided implant placement tools and techniques.
- Management of complications in dental implant surgeries.

He is a Brazilian dental surgeon who obtained his DDS in 2005 and holds Brazilian certificates in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OMFS), Implant Dentistry, and Oral Medicine. With over 15 years of experience in private practice, Dr. Mourão also served as a Lieutenant (Officer) in the Brazilian Navy as a dentist from 2014 to 2019. In 2012, he earned a Master's degree in Surgical Sciences from the School of Medicine at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRJ), gaining extensive experience in experimental research. He completed his Ph.D. in Dentistry at Fluminense Federal University (UFF) in 2017, focusing on clinical trials. Dr. Mourão further pursued post-doctoral research in Biotechnology at UFF from 2017 to 2022 and in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at UFF from 2018 to 2020. Dr. Mourão has published more than 160 indexed peer-reviewed articles.

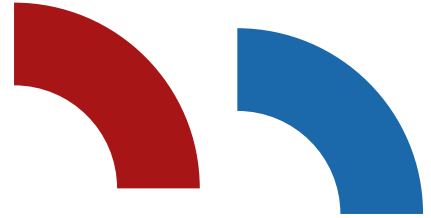
Not only is it an ideal location for conducting dental implant classes, but the training will also have an added social aspect: all practical cases will be free for patients due to the high demand for treatments among the population.
